Against the drama which accompanies a man from the beginning of time, when he wrestles with his nature not always directed to God and making bad decisions, always his divine source and goal is close. Of course, a man is not able to raise himself from this situation showing many times what he is able to do without God's source. Pride and selfishness make him fall prey to a blind fate and then apart to start to suffer an existential solitude, he begins to accuse for his bad behavior everyone else but himself. This is the experience the first reading speaks about today and it could be also a

good appropriate background to our Gospel. Fallen in paradise the first couple noticed their nakedness, it means, their own nature and then they hid themselves fearing of God the creator. In the same time they started to accuse each other and to the evil for their bad choices. The verdict of God is not a condemnation but rather encouragement to cooperate, to create a better world together with the promise of constant help from the part of God. Although the evil strikes a man at his head allowing him to organize the world without God, but at the same time thanks to a mysterious woman who will give an offspring it will become salvation which will strike the evil at this heel, not allowing him finally to win. The Gospel refers this experience of Jesus accused by the religious leaders of Israel for cooperation with the evil. Nothing more in the case of Jesus who, as descendant of this mysterious woman Mary, his whole life fulfilled the will of God introducing to everyone to be subordinating to God's will in faith. According to Jesus' teaching only those who listen to the Word of God

and put it into action in their life will gain the Kingdom of God being a firm and faithful friend of God, as was the case of the first parents in paradise before their fall into sin. Of course, death of the body, as an irreversible consequence of sin, did not stop God to fulfill His promise. The merits of Jesus Christ drawn from His salutary cross and our faith built on Him gives us through the Holy Spirit access to "a dwelling not made with hands, (but) eternal in heaven". Do not forget, this promise is valid to everyone today.

Mimo dramatu, który towarzyszy człowiekowi od zarania dziejów, gdy zмага się on ze swoją naturą nie zawsze skierowaną do Boga kiedy podejmuje złe decyzje, jego Boskie źródło i cel są zawsze bliskie. Oczywiście człowiek nie jest w stanie podnieść się ze swej upadłej sytuacji, pokazując wielokrotnie na co go stać bez Bożego źródła. Duma i egoizm sprawiają, że pada ofiarą ślepego losu, którego konsekwencją jest oderwanie od źródła życia i cierpienie związane z egzystencjalną samotnością. Wtedy zaczyna oskarżać o swoje złe zachowanie wszystkich oprócz siebie. To jest doświadczenie, o którym mówi dzisiejsze pierwsze czytanie i które mogłoby być również dobrym, odpowiednim tłem dla naszej Ewangelii. Upadła w raju, pierwsza para zauważyła swoją nagość, czyli własną naturę, a następnie ukryła się w obawie przed Bogiem Stwórcą. W tym samym czasie zaczęli oskarżać siebie nawzajem i zło za swoje złe wybory. Wyrok Boży nie jest potępieniem, ale raczej zachętą do współpracy, tworzenia lepszego świata wraz z obietnicą stałej pomocy ze strony Boga. Choć zło uderza człowieka pozwalając mu urządzić świat bez Boga, jednocześnie dzięki tajemniczej kobiecie, która wyda potomstwo stanie się zbawieniem, które uderzy zło w jego piętę, nie pozwalając mu w końcu wygrać. Ewangelia odwołuje się tu do doświadczenia Jezusa oskarżanego przez przywódców religijnych Izraela o współpracę ze złem. Oczywiście nie ma to nic wspólnego z Jezusem, który jako potomek tej tajemniczej kobiety, Marii, całe swoje życie wypełniał wolę Bożą, zapraszając wszystkich do poddania się woli Bożej w wierze. Według nauczania Jezusa tylko ci, którzy słuchają Słowa Bożego i wcielają je w czyn w swoim życiu, zyskają Królestwo Boże będąc niezachwianym i wiernym przyjacielem Boga, jak to było w przypadku pierwszych rodziców w raju przed ich upadkiem w grzech. Oczywiście śmierć ciała, będąca nieodwracalną konsekwencją grzechu, nie przeszkodziła Bogu w spełnieniu Swojej obietnicy. Zasługi Jezusa Chrystusa zaczerpnięte z Jego zbawienego krzyża i nasza wiara zbudowana na Nim, dają nam przez Ducha Świętego dostęp do „mieszkania nie rękami zbudowanego, (ale) wiecznego w niebie”. Nie zapominajmy, że ta obietnica jest dziś wciąż ważna dla wszystkich.

A pesar del drama que acompaña al hombre desde el principio de los tiempos, cuando este lucha con su naturaleza que no siempre está dirigida hacia Dios tomando malas decisiones, su fuente y meta divinas siempre están cerca. Por supuesto, el hombre es incapaz de levantarse de su situación caída, mostrando repetidamente de lo que es capaz sin la fuente de Dios. El orgullo y el egoísmo le hacen caer víctima de un destino ciego, cuya consecuencia es el desapego de la fuente de la vida y el sufrimiento asociado a la soledad existencial. Luego comienza a culpar a todos menos a él mismo por su mal comportamiento. Ésta es la experiencia de la que habla la primera lectura de hoy y que también podría ser un buen y apropiado contexto para nuestro Evangelio. Al caer en el

paraíso, la primera pareja notó su desnudez, es decir, su propia naturaleza y luego se escondió por temor a Dios Creador. Al mismo tiempo, comenzaron a culparse unos a otros y al mal por sus malas decisiones. El juicio de Dios no es una condena, sino un estímulo para cooperar, crear un mundo mejor con la promesa de la ayuda constante de Dios. Aunque el mal golpea al hombre, permitiéndole crear un mundo sin Dios, al mismo tiempo, gracias a una mujer misteriosa que dará a luz a una descendencia, él se convertirá en la salvación, que golpeará el mal en su talón, no permitiéndole finalmente vencer. El Evangelio se refiere aquí a la experiencia de Jesús, acusado por los líderes religiosos de Israel de colaborar con el mal. Por supuesto, esto no tiene nada que ver con Jesús quien, como descendiente de esta misteriosa mujer, María, cumplió en toda su vida la voluntad de Dios, invitando a todos a someterse a la voluntad de Dios en la fe. Según las enseñanzas de Jesús, sólo aquel que escuche la Palabra de Dios y la ponga en práctica en su vida ganará el Reino de Dios siendo un amigo inquebrantable y fiel de Dios, como fue el caso de los primeros padres en el Paraíso antes de caer en pecado. Por supuesto, la muerte del cuerpo, que es una consecuencia irreversible del pecado, no impidió que Dios cumpliera su promesa. Los méritos de Jesucristo extraídos de su cruz salvadora y nuestra fe edificada sobre Él nos dan, a través del Espíritu Santo, acceso a "una morada no hecha de manos, (sino) eterna en el cielo". No olvidemos que esta promesa sigue siendo hoy válida para todos.


